Sustainable Aquaculture Scheme

- 2 Project types open:
 - Organic Aquaculture
 - Capacity Building
- 8 Projects approved with a total investment of €1,034,912 and a total grants of €382,715.

Sustainable Aquaculture Scheme

- 1 project under Organic.
 - Organic certification for oysters
- 7 projects under Capacity Building
 - 1 UnaG
 - 6 BIM

Sustainable Aquaculture Scheme

- 2nd call for projects open until 27th May
- 3 projects received to date
- Total investment: €498,627
- Total grant aid sought: €233,201

Knowledge Gateway Scheme

- 4 Project Types
 - Innovation
 - Animal Welfare and Disease Management
 - Training and Networking
 - Advisory Services

Knowledge Gateway Scheme

- 6 industry applications received
- 5 projects approved at PAB with a total investment of € 305,138 and total grants of € 199,001.
- 1 recommended as more suitable for the SAS

BIM Work Programme

- Project tender processes complete and contracts in place
- IMTA– cutaway bog project: Perch and duckweed
- Seaweed cultivation– hatchery production
- Cleaner fish– lumpfish breeding and broodstock
