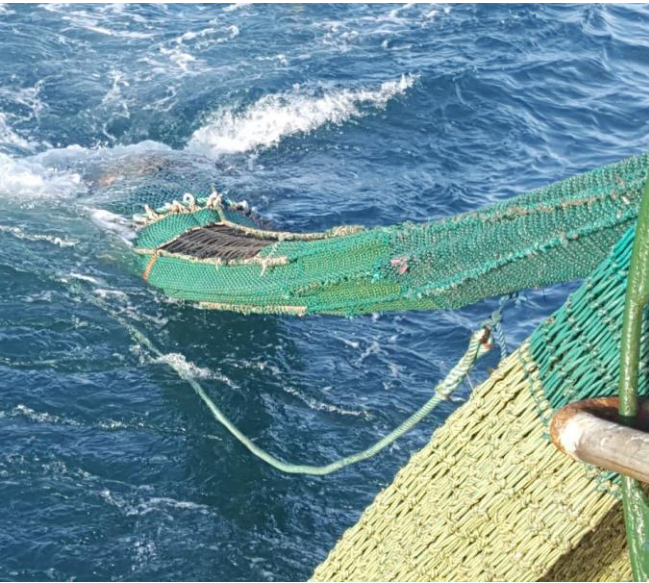

Study commissioned to consider uses of unwanted catches

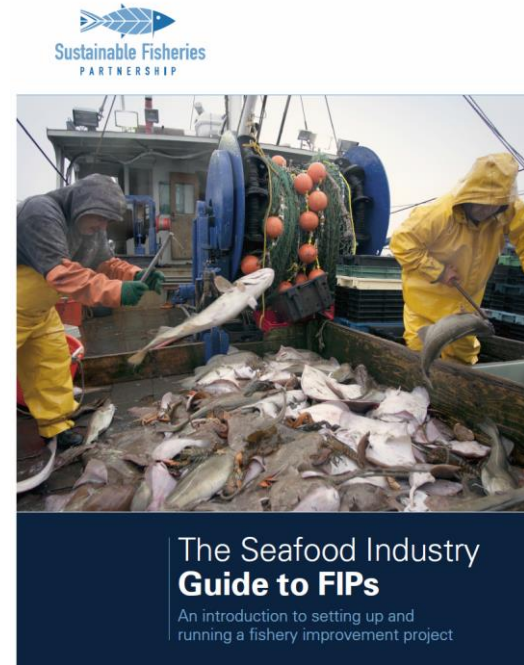

2. APPLY FOR GRANT AID

Submit Section C1 under the BIM Sustainable Fisheries Scheme, if grant aid is required and you are eligible. Find out more at www.bim.ie/schemes/



3. KNOW YOUR STANDARD

Receive a copy of the RSS scheme and familiarise yourself with the requirements.



4. GET READY

Prepare your document management and record keeping system.



5. PRE-AUDIT

Your RSS team will prepare you for your full audit.



6. AUDIT

Apply to the third party auditor, arrange a date. Be audited.
