Role of EMFAF Monitoring Committee

- Functions of Committee specified in –
 - ❑ Article 49 Common Provisions Regulation 1303/2013
 - ❑ Article 113 EMFF Regulation 508/2014
- Primary role – High level oversight of the OP and its implementation

Role of EMFAF Monitoring Committee

The EMFAF monitoring committee shall **examine**:

- Progress in programme implementation and in achieving the milestones and targets;
- Any issues that affect the performance of the programme and the measures taken to address those issues;
- Progress made in carrying out evaluations, syntheses of evaluations and any follow-up given to findings;
- Implementation of communication and visibility actions;
- Progress in implementing operations of strategic importance, where relevant;
- Fulfilment of enabling conditions and their application throughout the programming period;
- Progress in administrative capacity building for public institutions, partners and beneficiaries, where relevant.

Role of EMFAF Monitoring Committee

The EMFAF monitoring committee shall **approve**:

- Methodology and criteria used for the selection of operations, including any changes
- Final performance report:
- evaluation plan and any amendment thereto

The Monitoring Committee shall be consulted on:

- any proposal by the managing authority for the amendment of a programme

The monitoring committee may make recommendations to the managing authority, including on measures to reduce the administrative burden for beneficiaries.
